1.) To get to the main LFJCC Beanstack webpage go <u>HERE</u>. Once there, you will create your Beanstack account by pressing the button "Register an Individual or Family". If you already have a Beanstack account, select "Sign in".

2.) Once on the registration page, fill out the appropriate fields with your information. When you arrive at the question of who you would like to register, select "I am registering myself". Only adults are permitted to participate in this program.

While during the Beanstack registration process you will be asked if you'd like to register a child, children are not able to participate in this reading program. Please do not select this option.





3.) After you've registered you will be directed to your account page where you can register for challenges and begin logging your reading.

4.) Challenges you have not yet joined will appear under "More Challenges". To join a challenge scroll down to "More Challenges", select the challenge(s) you would like to join and click the button "Join Challenge" in the bottom right hand corner.





5.) For the <u>2021 Adult Summer Reading Challenge</u>, on the challenge's page, you will go to the tab titled "Bages" located under the challenge's title and image. This is where you'll officially begin the challenge.
