



Navigating Beanstack


1.) To get to the main LFJCC Beanstack webpage go [HERE](#). Once there, you will create your Beanstack account by pressing the button "Register an Individual or Family". If you already have a Beanstack account, select "Sign in".



2.) Once on the registration page, fill out the appropriate fields with your information. When you arrive at the question of who you would like to register, select "I am registering myself". Only adults are permitted to participate in this program. **While during the Beanstack registration process you will be asked if you'd like to register a child, children are not able to participate in this reading program. Please do not select this option.**



3.) After you've registered you will be directed to your account page where you can register for challenges and begin logging your reading.



4.) Challenges you have not yet joined will appear under "More Challenges". To join a challenge scroll down to "More Challenges", select the challenge(s) you would like to join and click the button "Join Challenge" in the bottom right hand corner.

5.) For the 2021 Adult Summer Reading Challenge, on the challenge's page, you will go to the tab titled "Badges" located under the challenge's title and image. This is where you'll officially begin the challenge.



For this summer reading challenge, you will be able to log and track pages read, write books reviews, collect badges, and connect with other book lovers, all while engaging with exciting Jewish authors and literature!

Read 250 pages to receive your first virtual badge! After 500 total pages read you will qualify for your first LFJCC prize. Reading in this challenge is cumulative


6.) There are a total of 12 badges available in this challenge: 10 logging bages, which is when you will log your pages read, and 2 challenge badges, 1 of which is awarded when you join the challenge and the other when you complete it. The badges with the ribbon symbol attached in the upper right hand corner include prizes for reaching those reading milestones.



7.) Get started with the "Novice" badge! Once you've clicked it, select "Log Next Page". You'll be directed to another page asking how you'd like to log. Select the "Log Pages" graphic to proceed to the next step.



8.) For logging, first select the day on the calendar in which you've completed your portion of reading. Enter how many pages were read, then the title and author (this is not required but we recommend including this information anyway) then select whether or not you'd like to include a review. Finally, select "Log" at the bottom of the page.


