Committee Descriptions

The following committees are in charge of the specific events and functions.

SHABBAT / HAVDALAH / TRIPS:

Teens will organize, plan, budget, and promote Shabbat, Havdalah, and Teen trips throughout the year. They will help in the planning of community wide events such as ski/snowboard trips, bonfires, concerts, etc...

JSERVE: A DAY OF COMMUNITY SERVICE AND LIKE ISRAEL PROJECT:

Teens will work with TLC and the San Diego community to plan JSERVE's Day of Community Service and the Like Israel Project. Works closely with other San Diego community organizations to put on successful projects that unite the community in helping to repair the world and engage teens.

TEEN SCREEN @ JEWISH FILM FESTIVAL & JEWISH BOOK FAIR EVENT:

Teens will choose, plan, and promote the Teen portion events at the prestigious Jewish Film Festival and Book Fair events. Will meet with committee to watch, discuss and choose movie selection for teens as well as plan and design the Teen Screen. Works closely with Jewish Film Festival and Book Fair in regards to producing a successful teen event.

SENIOR BUDDIES/TECHNOLOGY TEACHERS:

Teens will work with committee to attend and improve Senior Buddies. Each member will be asked to meet with Senior Department to plan a presentation to give to senior citizens about technology. You will participate in monthly Senior Buddies community service events.

COMMUNITY SERVICE CARAVAN:

Teens will plan and lead the JCC Middle School teens on bimonthly community service and fun events throughout the year. You will work on developing events to engage the middle school teen population.

SPORTS: TEEN TOURNAMENTS & JCC MACCABI GAMES:

Teens will work with TLC and community to put on teen tournaments throughout the year. This includes the Teen Dodgeball Tournament, 3v3 Basketball Tournament, and promotion on the JCC Maccabi Games.

AIPAC/MARCH OF THE LIVING:

Teens will work to research, plan and recruit for the AIPAC and MOTL events. Committee will meet with AIPAC and MOTL representatives and help plan educational events about these events.

COLLEGE PREP/COLLEGE TRIPS:

Teens will bring speakers, workshops and plan events for the teen population about college. You will be tasked with planning a "College 101" event that informs high school students about college on and off campus.

TLC COMMUNITY SERVICE MONTHLY PROJECTS:

Teens will work with community service organizations to plan monthly TLC community service projects. Whether it is planning a TLC trip to the homeless shelter or creating a food drive for TLC, each month this committee will be responsible for planning or creating a community service event for TLC to participate in.

ORGANIZATION PARTNERSHIPS/ SOCIAL MEDIA:

Teens will network with other San Diego teen organizations to brainstorm ways in which TLC can partner with other organizations for projects and events. Will be tasked to meet with other organization teen leaders and work with TLC sub-committees to create partnerships among San Diego teens.

In addition to committee participation, TLC members are expected to actively engage and participate in JCC Teen Department social events.
